Facts: George Brewer gave to his son-Jones Brewer land along the north side of the Haw River beginning at William Brewers corner on William Pett's line to little river, 247 acres on Jan14, 1807 - Chatham Co, NC.

George Brewer -1823 - Admin. bond 10Nov1823 Jones Brewer, Admin., John W. Bynum and Isaiah Burnett -Securities.

book P page 186 - Chatham Co, NC, this indenture made in 1805 names John Norwood, Henry Norwood, William Bynum and Riebecca his wife, Jones Brewer and Sarah his wife, Isaac Kerby and Nancy his wife, Jesse Nevils and Winefred his wife, and William Rosser and Elizabeth his wife. Heirs of Peter Norwood deceased of Chatham Co, NC.

Jones Brewer left no will, but his Estate Settlement file contains a receipt for a coffin dated January 3, 1853.

Circuit Court Minute Book D, page 377-378 - dividing 18 slaves - by making 9 lots and naming the slaves --Lot 1 drawn by Geo. Brewer, lot 2 drawn by Sally Brewer, Lot 3 drawn by Peter Brewer, Lot 4 drawn by Milly Jernigan, Lot 5 drawn by Edmond Brewer, Lot 6 drawn by heirs of Wm. Brewer, Lot 7 drawn by Henry Brewer, Lot 8 drawn by Addison Brewer, Lot 9 drawn by John N. Brewer.

Mrs. Sally Brewer was the widow of Jones Brewer and she received the slave Alfred. When Sally died there was a County Court petition in which they sold Alfred in order to settle her estate. In this County Court Petition it names Calvin, Enoch, and Green Brewer living in Arkansas as the only living children of Wm. Brewer a deceased son of Sallie Brewer. (Angelette Brewer Hill was already deceased)

Another deed dated 5Aug1853 names 4 people in Van Buren Co, Ar. (Green, Calvin, Enoch, Angelett Brewer Hill & husband) this land is being transferred to John N Brewer land formerly lived on by Jones Brewer. Another deed has Jones Brewer of Marshall Co, Ky. dated 25Mar1863

From land deeds Samuel Jones may have been a relative of George Brewer and believe that is where Jones Brewer got his name.

## JONES BREWER

From a volunteer librarian at the Gorham Macbane Library in Robertson County, Tennessee -

The area Jones Brewer lived in was on the Simpson Co, Ky. line and that may explain those listed as being born in Ky. as the Tennessee-Kentucky line was moved a couple of times and was finally established as it stands today.

Taken from Past Robertson County, Tn. historian Jean Durrett files:

A. L. Dorsey late of Springfield conducted an interview with "Tom Jeff Brewer (10-9-42)"

Q. What kin was Jones Brewer to you?

A. My great grandfather.

Q. Where did Jones Brewer live?

A. Bob Drake now lives on the old Jones Brewer place.

Q. Where is that from Orlinda?

A. Mile and a half from Orlinda.

Q. What road is that on?

A. On the Springfield and Mitchellville Road - dirt road.

Q. Where is Jones Brewer buried?

A. He is buried at the Brewer graveyard. He give a deed to an acre, and it is one the record here - to the Brewers.

Q. How far from Orlinda and in what direction is this graveyard?

A. Northeast, 1 1/2 miles.

Q. About when did Jones Brewer come to Robertson County?

A. About 1812 or 1814.

Q. Where did he come from?

A. North Carolina; first sopped at the Sallie Patch place in the 1st dist, and stayed there 2 yrs., and then to the old Tom Groves farm, 2nd dist., stayed there 2 yrs.; then he moved onto the North Prong of Red River, Duer's mill and stayed there fro about 60 years; then he went to Simpson Co., Ky., on part of the John R. Denning farm which his wife heired, and live there until her died at age of 92.

Q. How many acres of land did he own around Orlinda?

A. Quite a territory; east of Orlinda, and north around -- but it was the old man's children.

Q. Who were Jones Brewer's children?

A. Addison Brewer, oldest; John N. Brewer; Milly Brewer; Martha Brewer; Edward Brewer; Henry Brewer

Q. Which one went to West Kentucky?

A. Billy Brewer who was the son of Henry Brewer.

Q. Who was your father?

A. Tom Jeff Brewer.

Q. Who was Tom Jeff's father?

A. Addison Brewer.

Q. Who was Jones Brewer's wife?

A. Miss Nard.

Q. Where was she born?

A. Somewhere on White's Creek in North Carolina.

Green Brewer and family came from Kentucky and bought land at Shiloh, Van Buren/Cleburne Co., Arkansas in late 1830's(?). (Notes from book "Time and the River") -" SHILOH - is a biblical name meaning "place of rest or tranquility". Arkansas made a state in 1836. During the war of 1812 the US government gave a bounty of 160 acres in Arkansas to any soldier who would enlist. Migration in 1840 was from Ky or Tn. In 1840 census Cleburne Co, Ark. the family names in Giles township which covered the western half of the county were Allen, Allison, Bailey, Bittle, Bean, Brewer, Callister, Cayto, Collums, Cornwell, Doile, Draper, Edmunds, Farmer, Goff, Gill, Goodman, Gainer, Grimes, Hardin, Kimble, Olive, Owens, Patten, Presley, Potter, Reeves, Roberson, Sanders, Swift, Turney, Winfrey, Woods & Young. The William Bittle family came from Graves Co, Ky in 1840. The family came down the Mississippi on a flat boat to the Arkansas river and up the Arkansas to the post. It is believed the Goff, Bittle & Brewer families came to Arkansas together".

Enoch Brewer listed in Sugarloaf in 1850. Calvin Brewer came to Giles Township in 1840. Green raised cotton, corn, hogs, and molasses. In 1860 living with Green is Isaac Brewer age 70 b. SC.

In March 1959 they began work on Greers Ferry Lake. The lake and dam were finished in July 1964 creating a 40,000 acre lake. This covered the original Brewer lands, family cemeteries, and several small towns including Shiloh. About the same area on the lake is a park named Shiloh. All the families cemeteries were relocated to Mount Oliver Cemetery near Heber Springs, Arkansas. Some of the people's names from the old family cemeteries

**were not remembered, so they were moved and labeled "unknown".**

**It is not proven that Sara was a Bittle. In the morality records of 1870 it listed the death of Sarah Brewer listing as born in Illinois, which is the listing for this Sara on some of the census. So it is believed to be Sara Bittle. Parents - William Bittle 1805 N.C. - 1875 / Jane Walker (1805-1870).**
